General Relief will NOT pay for:

Utility hookups
Previous delinquent utility bills
House or trailer payments
Phone Bills
Car Payments
Deposits

You will receive a written notice of approval, or partial payment of your request or denial of your request.

You may appeal that decision within ten (10) days of the receipt of that decision to the Harrison County Board of Supervisors. That appeal must be in written form.

In order to be financially eligible, your income must be at or below 75% of applicable Federal Poverty Guidelines.

You may be asked to verify income and expenses and/or proof of residency.

If unemployed, you must register with Workforce Development. You must apply for all other benefits available, i.e., FIP, Food Assistance, Unemployment, etc. Failure to cooperate with the receipt of other benefits will result in a denial of General Relief,

General Relief CANNOT supplement other state and federal benefits, i.e., SSI,SSD, FIP, etc.

The maximum payment for utilities (electric, heat, water) is \$150 per year.

Please consider your request carefully and be specific in Question 7.

Any assistance authorized by General Relief must satisfy the identified request for funds or no payment can be made.

No Payments will be made directly to the applicant, only to Vendors of service or goods. Payment by Harrison County is made on the second and fourth Monday of each month. If you are issued a voucher, that is a guarantee of payment. It is the applicant's responsibility to forward a voucher to the applicable vendor.
