



Employment Opportunity: ***Physical Therapist***

Harrison County Home & Public Health Department (HCHPH) is seeking a Physical Therapist (PT) contractor. The PT will plan and provide physical therapy services to our clients in their home in accordance with the Plan of Care and HCHPH policies and procedures. The PT performs functions which require substantial specialized knowledge, judgment and skill based upon the principles of psychological, biological and social services and must be able to make judgment accordingly. The PT reports directly to the Home Health Nursing Supervisor.

Qualifications:

- 1) Have graduated from a physical therapy curriculum approved by the APTA, or the CAHEA of the AMA, or the CME of the AMA and APTA.
- 2) Be currently registered/licensed as a PT in the state of Iowa.
- 3) Have at least one (1) year experience in an acute hospital or equivalent experience.
- 4) Have demonstrated professional behavior and appearance.
- 5) Possess good interpersonal communication skills.
- 6) Possess and maintain good physical and mental health, including current TB testing.
- 7) Possess US Citizenship or evidence of a valid Alien Work Permit.
- 8) Demonstrate ability to exercise independent judgment.
- 9) Demonstrate ability to function in an unstructured home setting.
- 10) Possess knowledge of principles and practices of physical therapy.
